These figures in round numbers, and about \$20,000 remains unpaid. Accordingly the Indians have so far received only \$40,000 of the \$186,000 appropriated, and that is the gist of the matter. Secretary Hitchcock has appointed an attorney to look into the legality of Brown's action in paying himself \$893,000 for store accounts, and it is expected that the president will also take a hand in the deal.
