EDITORIAL ON J. F. BROWN

Wewoka:

By a vote of 340 to 173 Governor John F. Brown, half blood, was defeated for re-election by Halbutta Micco, a full blood. Governor Brown is completing his fourth term and is regarded in Washington as one of the most influential chiefs in the Indian Territory. This probably will be the last election of the Seminole tribe, and the defeat of Brown will have a tendency to hasten the dissolution of the Seminole tribal government.
