the tribal property. The census roll made two years ago by the Dawes Commission is taken as a basis, and the town kings are given such information as will enable the Commission to strike off all names of persons who have died and add the names of all children that have been born, from the time this census roll was made two years ago, up to and including Jan. 1, 1900. The Commission has been in session since last Tuesday, and the session will continue for several days yet. When this work shall have been completed, the final rolls will be made up and transmitted to the Secretary of the Interior for approval, as provided by law.

Immediately thereafter, or certainly within the next few months, the lands of the Seminoles will be allotted and work of the government in the Indian Territory, as to that nation, will have been completed.
