the payment of just debts.

- 44. Be it further enacted by the General Council of the Creek nation That from and after the passage of this law no white man shall be allowed citizenship in this nation.
- 45. Be it further enacted That the Principal Chief of each District be and are hereby authorized and requested to furnish the Creek Agent with the names of White Men not entitled or admitted(sic) to citizenship for their exclusion from the Creek Nation.
- 46. Be it enacted by the general council That all Licens(sic) traders setling(sic) in this Nation shall pay a tax of one hundred Dollars for each and every traiding(sic) house and should any Pedler(sic) come into the Nation and exibit(sic) articles that are not eatables for sale shall pay a tax of three Dollars per day it shall be the duty of Light Horsemen to collect all fines or taxes due for the violation of the above Law and all fines and collected(sic) shall be paid into the treasury.
- 47. Be it enacted That should any citizen desire to employ a white mecanic(sic) he or she may do so. Never-theless they shall have no power to retain them after they shall have completed their contract.
- 48. Be it enacted that no slave holder shall be held responsible for the contracts of their slaves.
