

73. Be it enacted That no slave shall be permitted(sic) to own or posses_ horses cattle or guns and should any slave or slaves be found in the possession of any property above described after the passage of the above law it shall be the duty of the Light horsemen and law makers to proceed and dispossess of the same.

74. And be it further enacted that all property taken by the provisions of the above law shall be sold to the highest bidder, and all monies arrising(sic) from sale of such property shall be turned over to the National Treasury.

75. Be it enacted That ther(sic) be a Treasury for Arkansas and Canadian Districts appointed whose duty it shall be to receive and receipt for all monies due the Creek Nation.

76. Be it enacted That Benjamin Marshall be and is hereby appointed Treasurer of Arkansas District whose duty it shall be to receive and receipt for all monies due said District.

77. And be it further enacted That David Barnett be and is hereby appointed Treasurer of Canadian District whose duty it shall be to receive and receipt for all monies due said District.

78. Be it enacted that all appropriations shall be made by General Council That neither of the Treasurers shall pay out any money belonging to the Creek nation unless it is upon a warrant signed by the Principal Chief and witnessed by the Clerk of the District for which Treasurer was appointed.
