

101. Be it enacted that the two school districts shall be designated by the following boundry (sic) beginning at the north of the North Fork running up the same to the mouth of the Deep Fork and up the same to its termination.

102. Be it enacted that the funds heretofore used for the support of Wagon Shops in Arkansas District be and is hereby appointed for the support of Blacksmith Shops in the Nation.

103. Be it further enacted that the funds heretofore used in the Canadian District for the support of Wheelrights(sic) be and is hereby appointed for the support of Black Smith Shops.

104. Be it enacted there be erected in each District two annual and two semi annual shops.

105. Be it further enacted that each annual Smith shall receive from the National Treasurer of the District in which he is located the sum of four hundred and fifty Dollars per annum but their Strikers shall receive from the same source the sum of one hundred and fifty Dollars per anum(sic).

106. Be it further enacted that the Semi Annual Shops shall commence operation(sic) on the first day of January 1857 and discontinue on the last day of June 1859.

107. Be it further enacted That each Semi annual Smith shall receive for his services from the National Treasurer of the District in which he is located out of the monies provided therefor the sum of two hundred and twenty five Dollars but their strikers shall receive Seventy five Dollars from the same source.
