Treasury except twenty-five percent which shall be divided between informer and Light horse men acting Informer getting one-half.

- 123. No negro or negros shall preach to an Indian congregation.
- 134. Negree may have religious worship within two miles of owners premises, when in conformity to the above regulations where there shall be some few persons not of negro origin to watch over their proceedings.
- 135. That should any person or persons give a slave or slaves a pass who does not belong to him or her and the slave should be apprehended and returned to their owner upon conviction offender shall pay owner one hundred dollars and receive one hundred lashes. In case he or she is not able to pay one hundred Dollars he or she shall receive an additional one hundred lashes and pay all charges for apprehension.
- 126. In case slaves should entirely escape the individual giving or writing the pass shall pay the full value of the negro as fixed by two disinterested persons to owner of slaves and receive one hundred lashes if not able to pay he or she shall suffer death.
- 127. Owners shall receive all fines assessed by valuation of the above law.
- 138. The above law to take affect from and after March 1st, A. D. 1861.
