

146. Be it further enacted that the Black Smiths shall be paid the sum of four hundred Dollars for his services and the striker two hundred Dollars.

147. Be it enacted that the Principal Chief of each District shall appoint the most suitable place for the locations of shops.

148. Be it further enacted that the Blacksmiths and strikers hired shall work from Monday morning till Saturday evening for the Nation.

149. Be it enacted that the Principal Chief appoint a superintendant over each shop, whose duty it shall be to collect all monies paid into the shop, and to see that the smiths and strikers do their duty, who shall receive for his services the sum of Sixty Dollars.

150. Be it enacted that the school fund shall be paid per capity(sic).

151. Be it enacted that from and after the passage of this law should any person or persons be found guilty of issuing tickets or shin plasters in the Nation except by order of the proper authorities upon conviction thereof shall be fined the sum of one hundred Dollars for each and every such offence.

152. Be it enacted That there shall be chosen or elected by this commity(sic) a suitable individual who shall sign issue and receive the change tickets or shin-plasters in behalf of the Creek nation to the sum of twenty Thousand Dollars.
