

ARTICLES OF AGREEMENT ENTERED INTO BY AND BETWEEN THE CADDO NATION AND THE DELEGATES FROM THE CREEK NATION THIS THE 4th OF JULY, A. D. 1867.

Whereas the piece(sic) and friendship which existed between the people of the Caddo Nation and the people of the Creek Nation have been partially disturbed by the killing of one Caddo the wounding of another and the capture of an amount of property as set fourth(sic) in their accounts agance(sic) the Creeks by the Light Horse companies of the Creek nation and

Whereas it is the desire of each nation to act with justice and humanity toward the other now therefore we the authorities of the Caddos and the Delegates on part of the Creek Nation do Mutually consent and agree to the following articles to-wit:

I. The Caddos agree to receive one thousand \$1000-00/00 as fixed and settled damages for the man who was killed.

II. They also agree to receive as fixed and settled damages 500-00/100 five hundred Dollars for the man who was wounded in the aforesaid difficulty.

III. They further agree to receive pay for the property lost and which was captured by the Creeks but in the event that the Creeks shall return any of said property the value of the same shall be credited in the accounts of the Caddo agance(sic) the Creeks.

IV. The Creeks in view of the covenants on part of the Caddo agree to pay the amounts specified I & II and also to
