MESSAGE OF SAMUEL CHECOTE

Executive Office M. N. October 5th, 1880

To the House of Kings and Warriors
In National Council Assembled.

Gentlemen

In accordance with the provisions of the Constitution and laws of the Muskegee Nation, I herewith submit my annual communication.

Since the last adjournment of your body, the general health of our people has been good and we have had a favorable season for our crops, so that we have to thank Providence for a prosperous year.

The emprovements made in the descipline of our

Educational Department, especially that br anch which has to

do with the neighborhood schools has been very marked. With

the present rate of improvement, it is to be hoped that our

schools will before many years be all that we can expect.

For particulars in regard to this department you are respect
fully referred to the reports of the superintendent of Public

Instruction and the superintendents of the Boarding Schools.
