

Your honorable body, during the same session, also passed a bill, providing that no permit should be granted for the employment of any citizen of the United States, as a laborer, and also providing that the bill should not be construed so as to prevent the employment of Teachers, mechanics, clerks, or physicians.

The National Treasurer has so interpreted the bill as to make it repeal the late permit Law providing for the issuance of permits by that officer,

You are respectfully recommended to take such action as will leave the matter no longer in doubt.

The law prohibiting the importation of cattle &c, into, or the driving of the same through, our domain, from the State of Texas or the Southern portion of the State of Arkansas, during certain months, has been in operation during the past year - but as no penalty has been affixed for a violation of the law - although our Light horse-men have turned several droves back - parties have not been deterred from still making attempts at violation. You are therefore respectfully requested to add to the law such a penalty for its violation as will guarantee its enforcement.

Many non-citizens residing upon our domain persist in pasturing their stock upon our pasturage, although such action is contrary to the intercourse law. Should your honor-
