

Whereas, the Thirty-Fifth Parallel Railroad Company, of the State of Arkansas, has, in a memorial submitted, by His Excellency the Principal Chief to the General Council offered to the Choctaw Nation certain propositions for the construction of a railroad from the East to the West side of the Nation, under a charter to be granted under the terms of the 6<sup>th</sup> Article of the Treaty of April 28<sup>th</sup>. 1866., therefore, —

Be it resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Choctaw Nation Assembled:

That a Committee, to be composed of three members of each House of the General Council, be appointed, to receive and consider the said propositions of the said Company; and that such committee be hereby required to report to the General Council, by bill or otherwise during the present session of the Council, the result of their deliberations upon the said propositions.
