

Be it resolved by the Senate, <sup>and House of Representatives</sup> of the Choctaw Nation assembled: That we protest, in the name of the Choctaw people, against any scheme involving the investment of the public moneys of the Choctaw Nation with those of the Cherokee, Creek, or Seminole Nations, for the purpose of constructing railroads, thus subjecting us for years to the necessity of resorting to taxation for the support of our government, and placing our funds in the hands of speculators, and out of our own control.

Resolved: That a copy of these resolutions transmitted, through His Excellency the Principal Chief, to the authorities of the Chickasaw Nation, to the Secretary of the Interior, and, through that officer, to the President of the United States and to each House of Congress; and that they be published in the Fort Smith Herald and Sherman Courier.
