

Resolution authorizing the appointment of a Treasurer pro tem, to receive & receipts for certain amounts of money now in the hands of Capt. Olmsted U.S. Agent, &c.

Be it Resolved by the General Council of the Choctaw Nation assembled: That the Principal Chief of this Nation, he, and he is hereby fully authorized to appoint One Competent National Treasurer pro tem, to proceed without delay, to the Choctaw and Chickasaw Agency, and to receive and Receipts for all moneys now in the hands of Capt. Olmsted U.S. Agent, in the name of this Nation, and whose Receipts shall be binding and in force against the Choctaw Nation. Said Treasurer pro tem, shall be required to call on any three persons of good character, to act as a body guard to & from said Choctaw & Chickasaw Agency; whose Compensation, as well as that of the Treasurer pro tem, shall be determined by the Principal Chief, and whose certificate of service, the same shall be <sup>upon</sup> ~~by the~~ National ~~and~~ <sup>to</sup> paid by the National Treasurer.

And be it further Resolved, that said Treasurer pro tem, shall turn over the whole amount of money received from Capt. Olmsted, U.S. Agent, to the Main National Treasurer, when demanded, taking his receipt for the same, and duly ~~signed~~ <sup>and</sup> ~~affixed~~ <sup>by the</sup> Principal Chief. In case of default, said Treasurer pro tem, shall be dealt with as the law directs in such cases.

And be it further Resolved, that this resolution take effect from and after its passage. — J.
