Sec 1 Be it Enacted by the general council of  
the Choctaw Nation assembled that the children  
of Mrs Elizabeth Frazer, viz Francis Folsom, and  
Margaret Folsom the children of Coleman Folsom,  
born out of wedlock be adopted as citizens of the  
Choctaw Nation and be entitled to the full  
privileges of the land

Sec 2 Be it further enacted that this act take  
effect and be in force from and after its passage
