Chief was notified that when it became  
necessary to convene the Grand Council  
that the Principal Chief of this Nation  
would be again notified of the fact—  
And Whereas the General Council of the  
Choctaw Nation is desirous of obtaining  
information in regard to the matter

Therefore—Be it Resolved by the General  
Council of the Choctaw Nation Assembled  
That—The Principal Chief be and he  
is hereby authorized and requested to  
Communicate with the proper <sup>Officers of the</sup> Depart-  
ment at Washington City—And Ascertain  
as to the time of the Meeting of the Grand  
Council Composed of members of the five  
Tribes of Indians in the Indian Territory
