particular.

An Act removing an Election  
precinct in Tobasei County of the  
Choctaw Nation,

Sec 1

Be it enacted by the General Council  
of the Choctaw Nation Assembled—

That the Election precinct in Tobasei  
County Choctaw Nation formerly known  
as *Insukka Simittas* precinct be and  
the same is hereby removed to South  
Canadian in the aforesaid County.

Sec 2

Be it further enacted &c. That all acts or  
parts of acts heretofore passed coming in  
conflict with this act, be and the same is  
hereby repealed, and this act take effect and  
be in force from and after its passage,
