

An Act removing and establishing an election precinct in Townson County in the Choctaw Nation

Sec 1

Be it enacted by the General Council of the Choctaw Nation assembled - That the Election Precinct heretofore established at Double Springs in Townson County of the Choctaw Nation be and the same is hereby removed, and established at Lexington in said County to be known as the Lexington Precinct

Sec 2

Be it further enacted so, that this act take effect and be in force from and after its passage, and that all acts or parts of acts heretofore passed coming in conflict with this act, be and they are hereby repealed
