An act entitled an act repealing an act
of the General Council.

Section 1.st Be it enacted by the General
Council of the Choctaw Nation assembled, That
the act passed October 12th 1871, limiting criminal
prosecution to two years is hereby repealed, and
that this act take effect and be in force from
and after its passage
