

To the Senate and House of Representative
of the General Council of the Choctaw Nation.

The undersigned joint committee of
the Senate and House of Representatives, be
leav[e] to report that they have had the report
of the Superintendent and district School
trustees under consideration and find the
same to be correct; and your Committee having
completed their business in relation to
School, your Committee would recommend
the passage of the following bill and ask
to be relieved.

Sect 1^d. Be it enacted by the General Council
of the Choctaw Nation assemble. That the sum
of eighty eight dollars is hereby appropriated
to pay E.S. Fendall out of any moneys
in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated
to pay for tuition of ~~five~~ Choctaw
scholars who are ~~not~~ of Choctaw blood, having
attended the Limestone Gap neighborhood
School; and the auditor is hereby authorized
to issue his warrant which shall be paid
by the Treasury out of the funds arising
out of the royalty funds.

Sect 2^d. Be it further enacted. That this act
take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
