

Your Committee to whom was referred the report of the National Auditor for the year ending July 31st 1878, beg leave to report that they have examined the same and find that all the warrants, have been issued agreeable to law, except the following, No 675. Calvin Harley Sheriff of Red River County, for thirty seven dollars $5\frac{1}{10}$ ($\$37.50$), eighteen $7\frac{1}{10}$ dollars, ($\$18.75$) more than the law allows, and No 702. G. W. Gardner County Judge of Blue County, thirty seven $5\frac{1}{10}$ dollars ($\$37.50$) twelve $5\frac{1}{10}$ dollars, ($\$12.50$) more than the law allows; No 778 to the same, twelve $5\frac{1}{10}$ dollars ($\$12.50$) more than the law allows, and 710 to Josiah Bryant Sheriff of Blue County thirty seven $5\frac{1}{10}$ dollars ($\$37.50$) - eighteen $7\frac{1}{10}$ dollars more than the law allows; Therefore your committee would recommend the passage of the following resolution.

1.st Be it Resolved by the General Council of the Choctaw Nation assembled, That B. G. Patten National Auditor is hereby instructed and directed to pay into the National Treasury the sum of Sixty two dollars and fifty cents, it being the amount issued on warrants No 675, 702, 710, and 778 in excess of the appropriation for that service.

Sect 2.nd Be it further Resolved, That the National Auditor may reserve the amounts issued in the above entitled warrants respectively in excess of the law, out of any certificate that may be held against the Nation by the persons to whom the above warrants were issued.

Sect 3.rd Be it further resolved, That whenever the auditor complies with the 1.st Section of this ^{Resolution} ~~Act~~ that his report shall be accepted as true and correct on the part of the General Council
