

An act declaring the embezzlement
of public moneys to be a felony.

Sec 1

Be it enacted by the General Council
of the Choctaw Nation assembled that
any holder or receiver of public
money who shall waste, squander or em-
bezzle the same shall be guilty of a
felony, and, in addition to the forfeit-
ure of his official bond, shall be
subject to indictment, ^{and} trial and con-
viction before the Circuit Court of
the county having jurisdiction, and
upon conviction shall receive one
Hundred lashes on the bare back.

Sec 2

Be it further enacted, that this
act shall take effect and be in
force from and after its passage.
