

An Act to grant to Jno. M. Hodges  
the privilege to build a bridge  
over Clear Boggy Creek on the Atoka  
and Boggy Depot road and establish  
a toll gate thereon

Sec 1

Be it enacted by the General  
Council of the Choctaw Nation assembled  
that the privilege is hereby granted to  
Jno M. Hodges to build a bridge over  
Clear Boggy Creek ~~at~~ just below the  
mouth of Delaware Creek on the road  
from Atoka to Boggy Depot, and estab-  
lish a toll gate thereon, upon the follow-  
ing conditions: that if the said Jno. M.  
Hodges shall erect a good and substan-  
tial bridge over Clear Boggy Creek  
at the above mentioned place, and  
shall keep said road in good order  
and condition for four hundred and  
forty yards on either side of said  
bridge, he shall be entitled to demand  
and receive therefor from all persons pass-  
ing over the said bridge, except from citizens  
of this Nation, the following rates of toll, to wit  
for each four-wheeled wagon or other vehicle  
drawn by four or more horses, mules or oxen,  
with driver, the sum of fifty cents; for each

four wheeled wagon or other vehicle  
drawn by one or two horses  
with driver, the sum of two  
cents; for each man and horse  
cents; for each person on foot  
for each animal in every drove of  
horses, hogs and sheep or other  
one cent.

Sec 2

Be it further enacted, that the privilege  
to collect toll herein granted shall  
take effect and be in force whenever  
the said Jno. M. Hodges shall well and  
truly erect said bridge, and continue  
so long as he shall keep the said  
bridge and road in good repair, and  
the privilege herein granted shall  
continue for a longer term than  
years -

Be it further enacted, that the
