

An Act establishing a series of Text books for use in the neighborhood schools of the Choctaw Nation.

Be it enacted by the General Council of the Choctaw Nation assembled, that the following series of Text books published by Messrs Van Antwerp, Bragg & Co., Publishers of New York and Cincinnati are hereby established in the Choctaw Nation for use in the neighborhood schools;

viz: Harvey's Script Spellers
 M. Guffey's Spellers and Readers
 Ray's new Arithmetics
 Harvey's Grammars (Revised)
 Eclectic U. S. Histories
 Montcith's Geographies
 Standard Registers (for teachers)
 Choctaw Definers.

Sec 2

District Trustees are hereby required to see that there are two or three depositories of the above books located in convenient places in their respective districts, and that the neighborhood schools shall be provided with said books, and each teacher with a Register on which to make quarterly reports in good style, and this act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
