Your Committee to whom was referred certain school accounts beg leave to report the following resolution thereon;

A Resolution instructing the District Trustees of the 2nd & 3rd districts to pay certain school accounts

As it resolved by the General Council of the Choctaw Nation assembled that the District Trustee of the 3rd district is hereby authorized to pay J. W. Smith \$125⁰⁰/_x for teaching Beaver Creek school in Seminola County for three months beginning Nov 29, 1880 and ending July 18, 1881 and Miss Amelia C. Butler \$84⁶⁰/_x for teaching neighborhood school at Durand Station in Blue County for three months beginning January 3, 1881 and ending April 6, 1881 and Miss Sophia M. Hair and Mrs M. S. Ketchum for teaching Carole neighborhood school from July 28 to May 31, 1881 ^{out of the unexpended balance on hand from last year's appropriation} \$137⁵⁰/_x and the District Trustee of the 2nd district is also hereby authorized to pay Delina Yateauki \$77²⁰/_x
