To the General Council

Your Committee on Schools to whom was referred the recommendation of the Principal Chief in reference to making the number of days and girls at school in the States equal respectfully report the following bill thereon and ask its adoption:

An act to make the number of days and girls at school in the States equal.

Be it enacted by the General Council of the Choctaw Nation assembled, that the Superintendent of Public Schools is hereby authorized and instructed; as fast as the first six days of the twelve who are now at school in the States, and known as the Royalty scholars; return from school; to fill the vacancies with girls, and this act shall take effect from and after its passage.
