To the General Council

Your Committee to whom
was referred; the application of
Mr John R. Dice for an advance of
\$3000 ⁰⁰/_x to be used in prosecuting the
claims of the Choctaw Nation against
the United States before the U.S.
Court of Claims, and the favorable
recommendation of the Principal
Chief thereon; favor the adoption of the
following resolution:

Be it resolved by the General Council of
the Choctaw Nation assembled that the
sum of Three Thousand Dollars is
hereby appropriated out of any mon-
ey not otherwise appropriated as an
advance to Mr John R. Dice to be used
in various ways in preparing the case
of the Claims - Wet Proceeds, Eastern
Boundary and Back Accretions - of the
Choctaw Nation against the United
States now pending before the United
States Court of Claims; said advance to
be returned to the Choctaw Nation out of
the five per cent of the Wet Proceeds
