Sec. 1. Be it resolved by the General  
Council of the Choctaw Nation  
assembled - That there be and  
is hereby appropriated out  
of any School money in the  
Treasury not otherwise appro-  
priated the sum of five hun-  
dred dollars to be placed in  
the hands of Rev. A. P. Stark  
Supt of Spencer Academy as  
a Contingent fund to be used  
as he thinks best, provided  
the said A. P. Stark make a  
full report to Edmund W.  
Curtain Supt of Public Schools  
of this amount or so much thereof  
as he finds it necessary to expend  
and that the Auditor issue  
his warrant for that amount
