

A Resolution providing for copying the laws of the present session of the General Council -

Be it resolved by the General Council of the Choctaw Nation assembled, that the Principal Chief is hereby authorized to have a copy of all the acts and resolutions of general importance, passed at this session made and turned over to the editor of the Indian Journal for publication in that Journal, and the sum of Fifteen Dollars is hereby appropriated to pay for such copying out of any money in the National Treasury not otherwise appropriated, and the National Auditor shall issue his warrant therefor on the certificate of the Principal Chief, and this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
