Council of the Choctaw Nation  
assembled, that Z. J. Davis and  
family consisting of his wife Fanny  
Davis - their daughter Rose Ella  
and her husband F. M. Willis  
their children Sherwood, Morris,  
Carrie & Buford Davis, are hereby  
admitted to all of the rights and  
privileges of citizenship in the  
Choctaw Nation, and this act  
shall take effect and be in  
force from and after its passage.
