

An act to amend paragraph 4 section 7 chapter 2 of the late published volume of the Laws of the Choctaw Nation

Be it enacted by the General Council of the Choctaw Nation assembled that ~~that paragraph 4 section 7 chapter 2 of the late published~~ volume of the laws of the Choctaw Nation be and is hereby amended so as to read as follows

4 The National Agent contracting with parties who are non-citizens; shall require them to enter into bond with good and sufficient security to the United States for the use and benefit of the Choctaw Nation in the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars, to be approved by either the Secretary of the Interior the Commissioner of Ind. Affairs or the Principal Chief of the Choctaw Nation & conditioned upon their faithful compliance with their contracts and such contracts shall thereupon without further action become valid and binding upon the parties thereto. And no non citizen shall engage in any business contemplated by this act except a contract first be made with the National Agent and a permit be also obtained according to the laws of the Choctaw Nation

Said original paragraph 4 section 7 Chapter 2 is hereby repealed, and this act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage
