Whereas, it has pleased the
Almighty to remove from our midst
our esteemed friend and former Chief,
the Hon. Thompson McKenney, who departed
this life some time during the month
of December 1888. And while we bow in
humble submission to the wise dispen-
sation of Him Who controls the Universe,
yet, we mourn the loss of one who so
long served his people faithfully and
vacated ^{the} position as Principal Chief of
the Choctaw Nation with honor, and
always had the interest of his people
at heart. Therefore;

Sec. 1." Be it Resolved by the
General Council of the Choctaw Nation
assembled: That both Houses of the
General Council adjourn for two days,
Friday and Saturday 18th & 19th Inst. out of
respects to the deceased Thompson McKenney
and that each member wear the usual badge
of mourning for thirty days.

Sec. 2" Be it further Resolved, that
~~a copy~~ the National Secretary is hereby

required to send a copy of this resolution to the bereaved family of the said deceased Thompson M. Tenny and that this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
