Your Committee on petitions to whom I was referred the petition of John Taylor, County Judge of Skullyville County C.N. after having carefully considered the same, have agreed that the petition be granted and beg leave to submit the following Act, and ask its passage.

SEC. 1st Be it enacted by the General Council of the Choctaw Nation Assembled: That the sum of \$1000⁰⁰ One thousand Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, to refund ^{at above} that amount, borrowed of Skullyville County as an advance to Campbell R. Filore, Choctaw Delegate. And that the Principal Chief is hereby required to issue a certificate on the National Treasurer for the amount in favor of the County Judge of Skullyville County. And that this act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
