

An act Changing an Election Precinct in Kiamichi County, Choctaw Nation.

Sec. 1" Be it enacted by the General Council of the Choctaw Nation Assembled: That an election Precinct in Kiamichi County heretofore known as Clear Spring election Precinct is hereby changed and removed to Good-Land Station in Spid County to be called and known hereafter as Good-Land Precinct.

Sec. 2" Be it further enacted: That the the first election held at said Good-Land Precinct shall be on the first Wednesday in August 1890 and every year thereafter. And that this act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage
