

An act changing Clear Spring Court ground in Kiamitea County C.N.

Sec. 1" Be it enacted by the General Council of the Choctaw Nation Assembled: That Clear Spring Court ground in Kiamiche County be and is hereby changed and removed to Good-Land Station on the St. Louis and Sanfrancisco Railway in Said County, to be hereafter called and known as Good-Land Court ground,

Sec. 2" Be it further enacted: That in holding the first Court at the said Good Land Court ground, shall begin on the first Monday in January 1890, and the first Monday in each month thereafter the year round.

Sec. 3" Be it further enacted: That the County Judge of Said County is hereby authorized and required to appoint two or more competent persons to sell the former Court ^{house} at Clear Springs, who shall first give public notice thirty days previous to the sale in at least three public places in the County, and that the proceeds of such sale shall be set apart for the building of a new Court house at Good-Land above mentioned
