

An Act relating to citizens of the Choctaw Nation
taking the oath of Allegiance to the United States.

Be it Enacted by the General Council of the
Choctaw Nation assembled:

That any member of the
Choctaw Tribe of Indians, either by blood, adoption
or marriage into said tribe, & subject to the gov-
ernment of the Choctaw Nation, who has taken,
or may hereafter take, the oath of allegiance to
the Government of the United States, shall be
disqualified to hold any office of trust or profit
in the Choctaw Nation, and to vote at any Elec-
tion in said nation, and to be impaneled as
a juror in any court under the government
of said Choctaw Nation.

This Act shall take effect from & after its
passage & approval.
