

An act providing that the compensation of local trustees shall be continued for the current scholastic year.

Whereas an act was passed by the General Council and approved Nov 14. 1890 making an appropriation of Fifteen Hundred Dollars to pay Local Trustees in accordance with the old law, and whereas an act was passed and approved Oct 31. 1890 depriving the local trustees of the Choctaw Nation of their compensation after they had entered upon the performance of their duties.

Therefore

Be it enacted by the General Council of the Choctaw Nation assembled, that the sum of Fifteen Hundred Dollars which was appropriated in the General Appropriation Bill of Nov 14. 1890 shall be expended in payment of local trustees the same as it would have been expended had not the School Law of Oct 31. 1890 been passed, and this act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
