Whereas Willie Anderson of Jackson County
was convicted for shooting while intox-
icated, a bullet into a Pullman Car
at Atoka, Choctaw Nation, and whereas
we sincerely believe that the striking of
the car was entirely un-intentional
and whereas he has always been
a good citizen and we believe tru-
ly, that he will never again err
in such a manner but if par-
doned by his Excellency, The President
of the United States, will make a
valuable citizen, therefore,

Be it Resolved by the Gener-
al Council of the Choctaw Nation
assembled, That the President
of the United States is hereby re-
spectfully petitioned to grant
the pardon of Willie Anderson of
Jackson County and restore him
to his family and people. And this
Resolution take effect and be in
force from and after its passage.
