

An act changing the Court Ground  
of Cedar County.

As it enacted by the General  
Council of the Cherokee Nation,  
Assembled, that the County Court  
Ground of Cedar County is hereby  
removed three miles south of the  
said Pine Hill from what is known  
as Pine Hill Court Grounds to Sulphur  
Spring and it shall be called and  
known as Sulphur Spring Court  
Ground. The County Court of Cedar  
County shall hold its first session  
at Sulphur Spring Court Ground  
on the first Monday in January  
1892. And this act shall take  
effect and be in force from  
and after its passage.
