

An act changing an election precinct in Red River County O. W.

Sec 1. Be it enacted by the General Council of the Choctaw Nation assembled, that an election precinct heretofore established at Bayou, in Red River County, and known as Bayou precinct, be, and the same is hereby changed and removed to the Okolona in said county, and shall be known as and called Okolona precinct, and all the legal voters of Red River County are privileged to vote at said precinct on the first Wednesday in August, 1892, and thereafter, and that this act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
