To the General Council:

We your Committee appointed to examine the report of E. S. Bowman, Inspector North End Frisco Railway find that for the two quarters ending April 30, 1891 he collected and accounted to the Treasurer for the sum of \$2429.09. The report for the quarter commencing May 1st 1891 has not been by him made. We would therefore recommend the passage of the following resolution.
