

An Act for the relief of H. J. Jackman

Be it enacted by the General Council of the Cherokee Nation assembled. That the sum of One hundred and twenty three dollars and  $\frac{50}{100}$  cents thereof is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated to pay H. J. Jackman for digging and walling a well for capita (\$100.00) also to six window lights 21.00

Putting in the same 2.50

Total \$123.50

The National Auditor is hereby authorized to issue his warrant for said amount and the National Treasurer shall pay the same and this Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
