

An act designating places
for distributing Leased District
Money

Be It enacted by the General
Council of the Choctaw Nation
Assembled

Section 1st That in distributing or
paying out the leased district
money the National Treasurer
is hereby authorized to make
the payments at such place
or places in each district
or County as may be most
convenient to the beneficiaries

Section 2 That the National Treasurer
be and is hereby authorized
and directed to employ fifteen
men as guards during the
payment at a compensation
of two dollars and fifty cents
per day each

Section 3 That all acts and parts of
acts in conflict herewith
are repealed and this act
take effect from and after
its passage - Proposed by
James Dyer.
