

An act making appropriation to pay the  
expense of the Extra session of General  
Council convened in June 1873.

Be it enacted by the General Council  
of the Choctaw Nation Assembled, That  
the sum of three thousand ~~3000~~<sup>3000</sup> dollars  
be and is hereby appropriated  
out of any money in the National  
Treasury, not otherwise appropriated,  
to pay members of Extra session of  
General Council, its officers and  
eight horsemen on attendance, if any  
balance to <sup>be</sup> returned to the Treasury.

Be it further enacted that the  
National Auditor is directed to issue  
his warrant on the National Treasury  
and the National Treasurer pay  
the same, and this act, to be effect  
and be in force from and after  
its passage.
