

All act for the relief of G. W. Thompson,

ten and  $\frac{90}{100}$  (\$210.90) dollars be and  
the same is hereby appropriated  
out of any money in the Treasury,  
not otherwise appropriated to  
pay G. W. Thompson for services  
rendered as follows:
