

An act, entitled an act, granting
H. C. Page the privilege to open
and run a ferry on Potéau.

Sec 1. Be it enacted by the General
Council of the Choctaw Nation
assembled.

That the privilege is hereby granted
to H. C. Page to establish a ferry
on Potéau Creek, in Sugar Loaf
County, C. N. near the crossing
of the St Louis & San Francisco
Railway, and the said H. C.

Page, is hereby entitled to demand
and receive therefor, from all per-
- sons, passing on the same, except
from citizens of this Nation, the
rates of toll, to wit, - For each four
wheeled wagon or other vehicle
drawn by four or more horses,
mules, or oxen, with driver, the
sum of Fifty cents, for each four
wheel wagon or other vehicle
drawn by one or two horses, oxen
or mules, with driver the sum
of twenty five cents, for man
and horse, the sum of ten
cents, for each person on foot -
the sum of five cents. for
each animal in every drove of
cattle, horses, hogs, and sheep, the
sum of one cent

Sec 2

Be it further enacted. That the privilege to receive toll herein given shall not take effect until the ferry boat is completed, and in good and safe order for crossing over persons who may so desire, and shall continue in full force for the period of five years, provided, said Ferry Boat be kept in good order and repair -

Be it further enacted - That this act take effect from and after its passage -
