his warrant on the National

Two Hundred dollars, <sup>not otherwise appropriated</sup> in  
order that Theodore, R. Hall  
who is blind, may attend  
the Asylum for the Blind  
at Little Rock, Ark, and  
the Treasurer pay the same.  
and this act take effect  
and be in force from  
and after its passage
