

An Act recognizing the citizenship of Certain
Mississippi Choctaws.

Be it enacted by the General Council
of the Choctaw Nation assembled: That the
following Mississippi Choctaws, late arrival
to wit: Wm Child, Mary Child, Martin
Child and Emil Child; Lestie Jackson
Wilson Jackson, George Jackson, Joe Lewis
Amy Jackson are hereby recognized
as citizens of this Nation, and are
entitled to all the rights, privileges and
immunities of other citizens of this Nation.
And this act take effect and be in
force from and after its passage.
