An act to remove the election
precinct of ^{Winn} Nwini hikia to Pleas-
-ant Cove, in Jacksfork County
C. N.

Sec 1- Be it enacted by the General Coun-
-cil of the Choctaw Nation assembled
that the precinct within the County of Jacks-
fork C. N. heretofore known as Nwini
hikia be abolished, and that the voting
precinct to be substituted in its place
be at Pleasant Cove, about two
miles from Nwini hikia, and to be
called and hereafter known as
Pleasant Cove precinct-

Sec 2- Be it further enacted that the
first election held at said Pleasant
Cove precinct shall be on the 1st Wed-
-nesday in August 1896, and thereafter

Sec 3^d Be it further enacted that any
act coming in contact with this act
is hereby repealed and that ^{this} act shall
take effect ^{and be in force} from and after its passage.
