

An Act changing an election Precinct in Towns County. C. N.

Sect. 1. Be it enacted by the General Council of the Choctaw Nation assembled:— That an election precinct known as Bow-Ton Precinct in Towns County is hereby changed and removed to about seven miles north, to Stanley and Townsend's store in said County, and it shall be called and known hereafter as Fowlerville Precinct.

Sect. 2. Be it further enacted, That the 1<sup>st</sup> election held at said Fowlerville precinct shall be on the 1<sup>st</sup> Wednesday in August 1896: and all future elections shall be held there.

Sect. 3. Be it further enacted, That all acts or parts of acts coming in conflict with the provisions of this act shall be and the same is hereby repealed, and this act to take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
